

WELCOME TO THE III YOUNG SCIENTISTS CONGRESS!

We recommend that you arrive at the venue in good time, at least 30 minutes before the start of the event of your interest.

The journey time from the Sochi International Airport and Adler Railway Station to the Sirius Park of Science and Art is approximately 15 minutes by car (depending on the traffic).

To access the Congress venue, you need to <u>collect a badge</u> and <u>take a PCR test</u> for COVID-19. **An accreditation badge is invalid without a negative PCR test result.**

ENTRY TO RUSSIA FOR FOREIGN PARTICIPANTS

DOCUMENTS FOR CROSSING THE BORDER

To avoid encountering any problems when crossing the border, all foreign participants arriving from abroad are required to bring the following documents:

- ✓ a valid passport:
- ✓ a medical insurance policy valid on the territory of the Russian Federation;
- ✓ visa (if you need a visa to enter the Russian Federation).

Participants are **not required** to present a PCR test result for entry to Russia.

GETTING A VISA

OR

If you need a visa to enter the Russian Federation, you can:

- 1) obtain a **visa through an invitation for foreign arrivals** (for all Congress participants)
- 2) obtain an electronic visa (available for citizens of 55 foreign countries).

VISA BY INVITATION FOR FOREIGN ARRIVALS

After submitting all the required documents, Congress participants can obtain a short-term, singleentry Russian visa for the period **from 20 November to 7 December 2023** at foreign consular offices of the Russian Federation on the day of their application.

Visa = invitation for foreign arrivals + list of documents

An invitation for foreign arrivals is not an invitation to the Congress, but a separate document from the Congress organizers. The invitation for participants from foreign countries can be generated in the personal web office ('Visa support' tab).

Your personal information will be automatically uploaded from the <u>personal web office</u> to the document. You can manually add the city and country where you will be applying for your visa.

If you have found any mistakes or typos in your personal data in the application for participation, you can contact a Roscongress Foundation specialist to make changes to the personal data.

Download and print the invitation for foreign arrivals. Provide your Russian consular office with the invitation for foreign arrivals and the other required visa documents.

To receive a visa for entry into Russia, individuals in possession of an invitation must apply at the relevant foreign consular office of the Russian Federation. Information about the location of Russian consular offices can be found on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Russian Federation.

E-VISA

Can be issued to citizens of 55 foreign countries:

Andorra, Austria, Bahrain, Belgium, Bulgaria, Cambodia, China, Cyprus, Democratic People's Republic of Korea, Denmark, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, India, Indonesia, Iran, Ireland, Italy, Kuwait, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malaysia, Malta, Mexico, Monaco, Myanmar, Netherlands, Northern Macedonia, Norway, Oman, Philippines, Poland, Portugal, Romania, San Marino, Saudi Arabia, Serbia, Singapore, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Taiwan, Turkey, Vatican City, Vietnam.

The unified electronic visa is a single-entry visa. The validity of the single electronic visa is **60 days** from the date of issue. The permitted period of stay in the Russian Federation on a single electronic visa is **not more than 16 days** from the day of entry within its validity period.

The unified electronic visa is not free. To apply for a unified e-visa, it is necessary to fill in an application on the purpose-made website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Russia.

After paying for your e-visa you can print out or download the special notification on the mobile device to pass the control procedures while crossing the border.

SOCHI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

Sochi International Airport, also known as Adler Airport (AER), is the largest airport in Krasnodar Region and the closest airport to the Sirius Federal Territory. It is located near the coast of the Black Sea and serves scheduled domestic and international flights.

RESORT FEE PAYMENT

Congress participants checking into hotels in the Krasnodar Region and the Sirius Federal Territory must independently pay a resort fee of RUB 50 per day at the hotel*.

Exemptions from paying the resort fee are granted by presenting hotel representatives with an original document confirming the right to exemptions from the payment of the resort fee, or a duly certified copy thereof, in accordance with Article 7 of Federal Law No. 214-FZ dated 29 July 2017 "On the Experiment to Develop Resort Infrastructure in the Republic of Crimea, Altai Region, Krasnodar Region, and Stavropol Region".

TRANSPORT SERVICES

During the Congress, <u>regular free shuttle buses</u> will run from the suggested hotels, Sochi International Airport, Adler Railway Station and Accreditation point at Omega Sirius to the Congress venue and back.

The Young Scientists Congress will be held at the Sirius Park of Science and Art.

To avoid any inconvenience when accessing the venue, please leave any <u>items prohibited at the venue</u> at your accommodation or in your vehicle.

ACCESS TO THE EVENT VENUE

HOW DO I ENTER THE CONGRESS VENUE?

1 Pick up your badge.

We kindly ask that you collect your accreditation badge in advance at one of the accreditation points. To pick up your badge, please check that you have uploaded all the necessary data to your <u>personal web office</u>.

102 Take a PCR test.

The badge will be active once you present a negative PCR test result for COVID-19. You do not need to take a PCR test to collect your badge. You can collect your badge and then take a PCR test or do it in the reverse order.

More information on proper testing timing, see in the 'PCR testing and badge activation' section.

13 Check out your badge activation.

Choose one of four ways to find out if your badge is ready.

Leave items prohibited at the venue at your accommodation.

Upon arrival, each participant will have to go through the access control procedure. You may be asked to turn on your phone or laptop and show other equipment that you brought to the venue. Please carefully review the <u>list of items prohibited on the event venue</u> and pay attention to any exceptions.

05 Don't forget your passport.

Please don't forget to bring along an identifying document (passport) to the venue. You must present your passport at the entrance to the venue and keep it with you while you are located at the Congress venue.

BADGE COLLECTION

You must have an activated accreditation badge to enter the venue of the Young Scientists Congress.

Badges for venue access are activated by a negative result of a PCR test.

The badge is personalized and may not be transferred to third parties. It is required for participants to have on hand their badge and identity document (passport) at all times while at the Congress venue.

If the accreditation badge is lost or damaged, please go to the Help Desk or any accreditation stand.

WHAT DO I NEED TO DO TO PICK UP MY BADGE?

In order to get your badge prepared for issuance, the information in the <u>personal web office</u> must completely match the data in your passport.

In the <u>personal web office</u> you should:

1. Confirm participation in the Congress

2. Enter your personal information in full

in accordance with your passport

- 3. Upload a required photo for your badge with the following parameters:
 - Colour photo against a light background
 - o Photo size 480 × 640 pixels
 - Photo format JPG or JPEG
 - o Full-face photo with no headgear
 - Your face must take up at least 70% of the photo

Tab 'Personal information - Edit'.

4. Upload a scanned copy of your passport (pages 2 and 3)

Tab 'Personal information - Edit'.

Please make sure that the scanned copy is legible and contains complete information about the data you gave when registering, including the series and number of the document, the issuing date, the issuing authority, and a photo.

Formats: JPG, JPEG, PDF, PNG.

If you have forgotten your login and password, you can use the <u>login and password recovery</u> function on the personal web office login page or contact us by email: weboffice@roscongress.org.

If there have been any changes to a participant's ID since the application was completed, their personal data needs to be updated in the <u>personal web office</u> accordingly. If changes need to be made to fields that cannot be edited, a participant should inform Roscongress Foundation specialist whose contacts are indicated in the personal web office.



Before issuing a badge, an accreditation point attendant will make sure that the data specified in the <u>personal web office</u> corresponds to the ID document. In the event of any discrepancies, it will not be possible to issue a badge the same day.

To pick up your badge, please check that you have uploaded all the necessary data to your personal web office.

HOW TO FIND OUT IF MY BADGE IS READY?

There are several ways to find out or be notified when a participant badge is ready:

HOW DO I PICK UP MY BADGE?

Badges may be collected **in person** (upon presentation of the identity document (passport), whose details are indicated in the <u>personal web office</u>, and an original of personal data consent form) or **by a power of attorney**.

If a participant's badge is collected **by proxy**, the authorized person must present the following:

- Authorized third party's passport
- Original standard power of attorney
- List of participants
- Copies of the passports of all participants to be accredited
- Originals of personal data consent forms

A personal data consent form, a power of attorney form, and an example of how to complete it are available for downloading in the 'Badge collection' section of the Event website.

PCR TESTING AND BADGE ACTIVATION

WHEN TO GET TESTED?

Participants must take a PCR at one of the dedicated Congress testing centres **24 hours** before arriving at the venue for the first time but no earlier than **09:00** on **26 November**.

PCR testing at dedicated Congress testing centres is strictly by appointment only. Please note that only the participants with an appointment will be admitted to the testing centre.

Test result is valid until the end of the Congress.

HOW TO GET TESTED?

- **01.** Provide information about COVID-19 immunity in the personal web office.
- **02.** Find your ID in the <u>personal web office</u> and keep it in mind.
- **03.** Sign up for PCR testing in the personal web office.
- 04. Pay for PCR testing.
- **05.** Take a PCR test at the Congress' dedicated testing centres or use the service of off-site PCR testing.

WHERE TO GET TESTED?

Testing will be carried out at the Congress dedicated testing centres, which are provided by Rospotrebnadzor in Moscow, St. Petersburg and Sirius Federal Territory.

The results will be uploaded to the Congress information system automatically.



The results of tests taken at other laboratories will NOT be uploaded for accreditation at the venue.

PCR testing at dedicated Congress testing centres is strictly by appointment only. Please note that only participants with appointments will be allowed into the testing centre.

The locations and operating hours of PCR testing centres are available on the <u>Congress website</u>. *Please watch for updates*.

VIEW THE LIST OF TESTING CENTRES

DATA REQUIRED FOR TESTING

1. Information about your immunity to COVID-19

In order to be admitted for PCR testing, all participants must provide information about their immunity to COVID-19 in the personal web office:

- information about COVID-19 vaccination status;
- information about previous coronavirus infection (COVID-19) status;
- information about the presence or absence of COVID-19 antibodies;
- information about permanent residence and temporary addresses at Sirius Federal Territory during the Congress.

2. Congress participant ID

The ID is a participant's identification number in the personal web office. You can view your ID:

- on the badge (if it has already been received);
- in the 'Personal data' section of the personal web office next to the participant photo.



If a test is not associated with a participant ID, it **will not be possible** to send the test results to the Accreditation Centre in order to activate the badge to attend the event.

3. Medical treatment consent form / Consent for medical intervention for minors:

BOOKING A TEST

PCR testing at dedicated Congress testing centres is strictly by appointment only. Please plan ahead and sign up for PCR testing beforehand and arrive at the time of your booking.

To book a test go to the 'Booking a test' section of the personal web office. Choose the most convenient testing centre from the list and select a time slot.

Please note: in order to book a PCR testing you must fill in all the required fields of the questionnaire in the 'Data on immunity to COVID-19' section. Required fields are marked with an asterisk.

PAYMENT FOR TESTING

In order to pay for a test, you must provide the Congress participant ID of the person whose PCR test is being paid for.

How do I pay by card via the personal web office?	 Go to the 'PCR testing – Payment for PCR testing' section of the personal web office. Provide medical intervention consent (tick the checkbox). Click the 'Pay' button. Provide your ID or ID of the person whose PCR test is being paid for. Provide consent for personal data processing (tick the checkbox). Make the payment by card. Tick the field marked 'Get a receipt' and enter your email address in order to request a receipt. A receipt will be provided within 24 hours. Payments are made in Russian roubles. If the payment does not go through, please contact your bank.
How do I pay on behalf of a legal entity?	 Contact by phone or email: +7 (985) 621 8278 +7 (985) 886 1444 Forumysc@fcgie.ru Requests are accepted between 09:00 and 18:00 (Moscow time, GMT+3). Sign the agreement on behalf of the legal entity. Provide the full names and IDs of the participant or participants whose tests are being paid for in the agreement. Make the payment. Testing can only be carried out after the payment has been made in advance and in full. All agreements for PCR testing in all testing centres are signed with the Federal Budget-funded Healthcare Institution "Federal Centre for Hygiene and Epidemiology of the Federal Service for Surveillance on Consumer Rights Protection and Human Wellbeing".
How do I pay by cash?	Testing centres in Omega Sirius and Barkhatnye Sezony (Sportivny Kvartal) hotels have cashpoints where you can pay for the test in cash or by bank card. Payments are made in Russian roubles.
How do I pay by QR code?	All testing centers have posters with a QR code and instructions for paying for testing. You can pay for testing in the testing centre by QR code. But you should know your Congress participant ID number.

LAMP TESTING

Congress participants may test for COVID-19 by the loop-mediated isothermal amplification (LAMP) method. LAMP testing must be paid for.

Results are available within 1.5 hours.

To get tested, sign up using your <u>personal web office</u>. From the list of testing centres, select those with the LAMP prefix.

You can pay for LAMP testing following a link in the <u>personal web office</u>, at the testing centre using a QR code, or by legal entity testing contract:

At the testing centre, please inform the staff that you plan to be tested using the loop-mediated isothermal amplification method.

TEST RESULTS

Lab results will be provided within 24 hours. Before going to the Congress venue, please make sure that your test result is negative and your badge is activated.

ACCREDITATION OF PERSONAL VEHICLE

All Congress participants may obtain accreditation for a personal vehicle in order to access the Sirius Park of Science and Art. Accreditation requests will be accepted until 27 November 2023.

It is forbidden to transfer a transport pass or driver's badge to a third party. Should this occur, the pass and/or badge will be withdrawn and annulled.

BUSINESS PROGRAMME

The III Young Scientists Congress will be a key event in 2023 as part of the Decade of Science and Technology in Russia.

The business programme of the Young Scientists Congress will be enhanced by thematic events dedicated to the advancement of the Russian research and development sector, featuring exhibitions by leaders of the Russian science-intensive industry and business.

The **Russian Science Foundation School**, an esteemed scientific and educational entity within the Russian Science Foundation, is set to reopen its doors this year at the Congress venue. Sochi Park is a theme park in the Sirius urban locality. It is based on the concept of Russia's cultural and historical richness. The Park first opened to participants and spectators of the Olympic Games in Sochi. It has a theme park and the Bogatyr Hotel, which is designed to resemble a medieval castle. The Park has 22 attractions, including the Quantum Leap giant inverted boomerang, the Firebird free-fall tower, the Zmey Gorynych roller coaster, and the Perpetual Motion pendulum.

Tickets are provided free for participants and can be picked up at the information and services point of the III Young Scientists Congress (2nd floor, near entrance 1).

Visit to the History Museum of the Resort City of Sochi

Over the course of its century-long history since 1920, the History Museum of the Resort City of Sochi has transformed from a small collection of the Sochi branch of the Caucasus Mountain Club to one of the largest museum associations in the region, with a collection of 100,000 items.

The museum's exhibition includes 14 halls and depicts the history of the Black Sea coast of the Caucasus and the city of Sochi from ancient times until present with 6,000 unique exhibits, including archaeological artefacts, objects of the ethnography, life, and culture of the region's multinational population, as well as other unique objects, documents, and photographic materials. The museum's substantial collection reveals the eventful history of the resort city and lets visitors look at the city from unexpected angles. The museum's exhibition halls regularly host thematic exhibitions related to the history of Sochi.

Participants will need to purchase tickets for the museum on their own.

Visit to the Phanagoria State Historical and Archaeological Museum and Reserve

Congress participants can attend the tour 'Ancient Phanagoria: Myths about Archaeology and Science'. During the tour, Congress participants will have a chance to take an exciting journey through the world of Ancient Greece and touch the artifacts of a civilization that existed 2,500 years ago on what is now Taman Peninsula.

Participants can purchase tickets on their own at a reduced price by presenting their badge.

Visit to the Zhilinsky Sochi Art Museum

The Sochi Art Museum was founded by a decree of the RSFSR Ministry of Culture on 24 June 1971. The building was designed by the prominent architect Ivan Zholtovsky, and the museum has been granted the status of an architectural monument of federal importance. The exhibition presents works that represent a variety of trends in Russian fine art from the 19th-21st centuries (classicism, romanticism, realism, and socialist realism, which emerged in the first half of the 20th century). The works of academic school artists are widely and thoroughly represented, including works by Ivan Aivazovsky, Vasily Polenov, Nikolay Sverchkov, Vladimir Zarubin, and Lev Lagorio. Pre-premiere screening of the popular science film 'How Ivan Pigaryov Studied Dreams'

The film will show for the first time a unique newsreel from the 1960–1970s that was filmed at the Physiology Laboratory of the Institute of Applied Physics of the Russian Academy of Sciences and was kept in the Pigaryov family for a long time. The film also tells the story of Pigarvoy's predecessors – scientists who studied the physiology of sleep throughout the 20th century, for example, the experiments of the Vladimir Chernigovsky's laboratory at the Pavlov Institute of Physiology of the Russian Academy of Sciences.

The main characters of the film are modern scientists who reproduce Pigaryov's experiments and hold conferences on sleep: Director of the Sleep Medicine Centre of the Medical Research and Educational Centre of Lomonosov Moscow State University and Candidate of Medical Sciences Alexander Kalinkin; Professor at Lomonosov Moscow State University and the National Research University Higher School of Economics and Chief Researcher at the Institute of Evolutionary Physiology and Biochemistry of the Russian Academy of Sciences Mikhail Lebedev; Doctor of Biological Sciences and Chief Researcher at the Svertsov Institute of Problems of Ecology and Evolution Vladimir Kovalzon; and Research Fellow at the National Research University Higher School of Economics, Darya Kleyeva, among others. Neurophysiologist, Doctor of Biological Sciences, and Professor at Lomonosov Moscow State University, Alexander Kaplan will speak about Pigaryov's influence on his work as a scientist.


